**STUDENTS ENTERING NATIONAL TECHNICAL HONOR
SOCIETY
MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:**

- 1. The student must be a junior or senior and apply for membership with proper documentation from his / her home high school.**
- 2. The student must be recommended by his /her Mineral County Technical Center instructor(s) who will consider dependability, honesty, attitude, character, leadership and other related criteria.**
- 3. The student must be enrolled as a full-time student at the home high school MCTC. There shall be no academic modification for these classes and students shall have maintained 3.25 combined grade point average between the technical course(s) and their home high school classes. None of the high school classes shall be below a C using the Mineral County grading scale.**
- 4. The student must have a 3.5 average at the MCTC.**
- 5. The student must be engaged in a path for program completion at the MCTC.**
- 6. The student must have maintained an attendance record at the MCTC of no more than 3 absences per semester. (absences due to extenuating circumstances shall be reviewed on a case by case basis by the NTHS committee)**
- 7. Final approval of the entire list of recommended students for induction must be approved by each member of the Faculty Senate Sub-Committee for the NTHS and the MCTC director.**
- 8. The student being considered for membership shall have no suspensions or disciplinary actions on his / her record at the MCTC or at their home high school.**
- 9. Any student meeting the criteria that has been recommended by their instructor(s) has the right to appeal the Honor Society Sub-Committee if not approved.**
- 10. All students who are members of the NTHS shall maintain the standards for induction during their entire active membership in order to remain in the NTHS organization.**
